To the Board of Parole:

I am Wendy Nacamu, Aunt of Carolyn's grandchildren, sister-in-law to Tim Bolger and Robin Bolger's sister. I am writing this because I am afraid. I am afraid for everyone's safety. I am a single woman, this inmate's prey. He should not be released because he has showed a pattern of behavior that is dangerous to women. I am a school teacher. He has also admitted endangering dozens of others after taking Carolyn's life, in his fit of rage. I believe this type of person cannot be rehabilitated to be released.

The grief he has caused is obvious. The Bolger family has persevered day after day, year after year. The effects of the inmate's actions are a part of our family gatherings. His disregard for anyone but himself is dangerous. I would like my extended Bolger family, niece and nephew, my sister, and our parents to heal from the trauma this murderer is responsible for. I ask he continues rehabilitation in prison with the maximum time set by the law for a possible parole hearing.
